What's the Least I Can Get By With?

We have all had experience with one of these kinds of people somewhere, whether it was at work, school, or somewhere else. They seem to have no motivation and will only do the absolute least they can get by with. This is a bad attitude anywhere you find it, but it is especially bad when you find it among God's people. The scriptures are clear, God expects our best. He doesn't expect us to do what we cannot do, or to do the same as someone else, but He does require that we do the best that we can do. Sometimes the blessing we receive can be in direct proportion to the work we put in. In 2 Kings 4:1-7 a widow's sons were about to be taken as slaves to pay a debt; the prophet Elisha told her to "borrow vessels from everywhere, from all your neighbors empty vessels; do not gather just a few." She was to pour oil from a jar she had into the vessels she had borrowed. When there were no more vessels, the oil ceased (vs 4-6). The widow was to sell the oil to pay the debt and she and her sons were to live off the rest. The more vessels she borrowed, the more oil that she had to sell. In 2 Kings 13, Joash is told by Elisha to "Strike the ground'; so he struck three times, and stopped. And the man of God was angry with him, and said, 'You should have struck five or six times; then you would have struck Syria till you had destroyed it! But now you will strike Syria only three times." (vs 18-19). King Joash missed his chance to destroy Syria because he didn't do as much as he could have. In Luke 21:1-4 Jesus praises a poor widow who put a small amount of money into the treasury, not because she gave a larger amount than others, but because she gave all she could. "Truly I say to you that this poor widow has put in more than all; for all these out of their abundance have put in offerings for God, but she out of her poverty put in all the livelihood that she had." God will never be pleased with our efforts if we are just doing "the least we can get by with". God requires our best efforts. He may not require that we give all that we have, but He certainly expects us to be willing to give it.
