# Worship is Serious Business

Even though worship is such an important part of being a Christian, there are many people who either don't take it seriously or don't understand it. First of all, some think that anything we do can be an act of worship. This is not true. We don't decide what is or is not worship; God does. God makes the rules as to what is worship, and when and how it is to be conducted; we do not. There is a cautionary account about worship found in Leviticus 10:1-3. Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, are going to offer incense to God but they used fire from a source that God had not authorized. Consequently, "fire went out from the Lord and devoured them, and they died before the Lord." (verse 2). Nadab and Abihu decided to change this act of worship on their own authority, and we know this because of what God told Moses in verse three, "By those who come near Me I must be regarded as holy; And before all the people I must be glorified." In choosing to do other than what God commanded, Nadab and Abihu were not regarding God as holy. People also seem to think that their attitude is the only thing important in worship. Attitude is most certainly important, but it is not the only important thing. A "good attitude" will not turn improper worship into something pleasing to God. Likewise, no matter how proper our worship may be performed, without the right attitude it is useless. We need to remember that an act of worship is an act of worship because God said so. How the act of worship is performed and the attitude behind it can make it either an acceptable act of worship or one that is unacceptable. But it does not change the nature of what is or is not worship. In Ecclesiastes 5:1 Solomon said, "Walk prudently when you go to the house of God; and draw near to hear rather than to give the sacrifice of fools, for they do not know that they do evil." We need to take worship seriously. We need to study God's word to make sure we are worshiping as God commands. We need to prepare ourselves before worship so that we can properly focus our minds. And we must always keep in mind that we are not the audience, but rather we are there to offer proper, heartfelt worship to the most holy God of heaven.
